

MISSION TO HAITI

JAN 15-24, 2024

Population: 11.8 million

Primary Language: French/Creole

Avg January Temp: 75°

Trip Cost: \$1,600/person



Beauvoir Deshommes (pictured left with Darrie Nelson, Executive Director of Riverside Bible Camp) runs the Christian School of Providence in Lajene, Haiti. As of April 2023, there were 120 children enrolled in the school, and Beauvoir and his wife care for 22 children in the orphanage. In addition to his duties at the school and orphanage, Beauvoir also pastors a church of over 60 attendees that has been meeting at the school until a church building can be constructed on the property. One of the primary goals of this trip will be to construct a roof for the new building if the needed funds can be raised.



Riverside's goal, in partnership with Faith Community Church, is to assemble a team of 15 missionaries who will be broken into three teams, each team working to achieve very specific objectives during our time in Haiti.

TEAM 1

A ministry team to the children in the orphanage/school.

TEAM 2

An evangelistic ministry team to the surrounding community.

TEAM 3

A construction team that will be completing the roof on a new church building (*if the \$15,000 needed to construct the building can be raised*). Painting the church and other structures may also be part of the trip as well as constructing benches & other items.



WHAT TO EXPECT

- With the fragile political situation in Port au Prince, participants should be prepared for the trip to be postponed if the country becomes too unstable.
- Third World living conditions such as: limited electric, cold/bucket showers, rudimentary bathrooms, limited internet
- Haitians will provide all meals (and they're delicious!)
