

Riverside Bible Camp: Packing List/Additional Information

Arrival/Departure:

Arrival/Check-in takes place from 3:30 - 5:00 PM on the first day of camp. Please plan to arrive when check-in begins as you will be responsible to supervise your children until that time.

Departure/Check-out takes place at 11:00 AM on the last day of camp. Please plan to check-out your child before leaving the camp grounds.

Packing Information:

Please do **NOT** bring the following:

- Clothing with questionable words/graphics
- Food, candy or beverages
- Firearms, knives or other weapons
- Fireworks
- Cell phones, electronic games or other personal entertainment equipment

Clothing Guidelines:

- Shirts should cover the stomach and not be low cut or bare back
- Tank tops for girls should have 1" straps
- Shorts should be relaxed and at least thumbnail length; skirts fingertip length
- Guys' swimsuits must be trunk-style; girls' suits are to be one piece
- Swimwear is only to be worn at the swim area (we ask that the camper wears a shirt and shorts over swimsuits to and from the waterfront).
- Shoes must also be worn to and from the waterfront.
- All clothing, luggage and personal items should be labeled with camper name.

Additional Packing Information:

- Bible/Pencil/Notebook/Materials for writing home
- Sleeping bag and/or bedding and a pillow
- Towel/Washcloth
- Camp clothes (outdoor clothes you are able to get dirty/long pants)
- Closed toe shoes (tennis shoes for recreation)
- Toothbrush/Toothpaste/Shampoo/Soap/Deodorant
- Flashlight/Raincoat/Insect Repellent
- Optional - Camera

Please keep in mind that...

Campers are expected to follow the camp schedule.

Personal conduct will be compatible with the Christian ideals of the camp which excludes the use of tobacco, drugs and alcohol.

No one may leave the camp early except by permission of the director.

Sickness or injury must be reported immediately to the camp nurse.

The camp management reserves the right to send anyone home for misconduct.

Medications

Medications must be in the original prescription bottle showing the camper's name and non-expired date. Please place medications in a plastic ziploc bag with the camper's name on the bag.

Riverside Bible Camp does not provide health or accident insurance for campers; all expenses incurred are the responsibility of the camper's family. Parents, you can be assured that the best available care will be given your child if a need arises.

Cancellations

If you need to cancel your registration, please notify us as soon as possible. Your courtesy may help another camper on the waiting list be able to attend camp. As indicated on the brochure, registration deposits are not refundable or transferable.

Cabin Requests

If you would like, you may request cabin buddies on the registration form. A buddy group consists of a camper and one or two other campers. Cabin buddies must request each other for the request to be considered. Please contact the camp for any changes or additions. As cabin assignments have already been completed, cabin requests will not be accepted at the time of check-in.
